The Bernice and Larry Robbins Scholarship was established in 2012 by "LR" Robbins, a 1967 graduate of Highland Park High School, as a Robbins family legacy initially honoring Highland Park High School. Mr. Robbins is a District administrator, serving as deputy superintendent of Topeka Public Schools since 2011.

Scholarship Selection Process:

- 1. A committee will review all applications. The committee shall be comprised of the High School principal, division principal and counselor.
- 2. The Division High School principal will review all applications and choose up to five finalists. The five finalist applications will be reviewed by the committee and the donors who will make the award selection.
- 3. The recipient will be selected on the strength of the candidate's GPA, written application material and financial need.

Deadlines and Process

- 1. All applications to be considered must be received by the Topeka Public Schools Foundation by March 15.
- 2. Applications will then be forwarded to the Highland Park High School principal or designee.
- 3. The committee will make a decision on the recipient no later than April 15.
- 4. The award will be made by TPSF upon receipt of proof of acceptance of a college offer for the recipient submitted to the TPSF office (see address below).
- 5. The check will be made out to Washburn University and the student

Scholarship Information:

1. One \$1000 non-renewable scholarship.

Scholarship Requirements:

- 1. Be a graduating minority senior at one of the TPS High Schools.
- 2. Be planning to attend Washburn University.
- 3. Have a minimum 2.8 GPA.
- 4. The award will be made upon receipt of proof of acceptance of a college offer for the recipient.
- 5. The check will be made out to Washburn University and the student.
- 6. Students must maintain Full time university status.
