




TPS 4-YEAR DISTRICT GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME




TPS DISTRICT GRADUATION RATES BY GENDER




TPS 4-YEAR DISTRICT GRADUATION RATES BY RACE




TPS 4-YEAR DISTRICT GRADUATION RATES BY SUBGROUP




TOPEKA HIGH GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME




TOPEKA WEST GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME




HIGHLAND PARK GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME



HOPE STREET GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME




CAPITAL CITY GRADUATION RATES OVER TIME




